Grammar Programs -- Netbook Version

Grammar Computer Record Sheet: A printable file for keeping records of your students' progress as they use the Grammar programs.

Color Coding and Diagramming Tutorials: Links to a complete set of tutorials explaining how the concept of color coding and diagramming is used with the following concepts:

- **Level 1** – Simple sentences; no prepositional phrases
- **Level 2** – Simple sentences with prepositional phrases
- **Verbals** – Gerunds, participles and infinitives
- **Infinitives** – Infinitives and infinitive phrases
- **Infinitives used as nouns**
- **Infinitives used as modifiers**
- **Clauses**

Grammar Program Components:

Color Coding and Diagramming 1: Most of the programs are in the Flash Card format where the student is shown a sentence and asked to find the diagram that fits it. None of the sentences have prepositional phrases. The last program shows the student a diagram and asks them to find its diagram.

In Level 1, the student can click the "Show Me" button to have the computer do the problem, or the "Help" button to have the sentence color coded. The "Show Me" button is disabled in Level 2, and the "Help" button is disabled in Level 3;

Color Coding and Diagramming 2: This program features sentences with prepositional phrases. The rest of the program design is identical to the previous one.

Nouns: Three of the programs show the student a sentence and ask him/her to identify the function of the noun or the verbal. The “Help” button gives the student a hint in the form of a definition.

The fourth program, kinds of nouns, asks the student to differentiate among abstract nouns, proper nouns, collective nouns,

Parts of Speech: Classifying Nouns asks students to decide whether nouns are persons, places, animals, things, or ideas. It is in the grid format. Kinds of Nouns is described above. Tenses of Verbs has the choices of Present Tense, Past Tense, Future Tense, Present Perfect Tense, Past Perfect Tense and Future Perfect Tense. In Parts of Speech the choices are noun, pronoun, adjective, adverb, verb and preposition. There are no levels in this program.
