Language Arts Course

Designed as a "family-friendly" course, the lessons are easy for parents, teachers, and students to follow. The structured, sequential and self-correcting approach to language arts instruction allows the parents/teachers to set the pace of the instruction according to their students' needs and abilities. Since the materials are self-correcting, students are encouraged to take responsibility for their own work and become more independent learners.

The hands-on, visual approach utilizes sentence diagramming techniques, printable worksheets, manipulatives and instructional materials for teaching grammar. Students and parents are also given the tools for making and using Study Units, Terms and Definitions manipulatives, and tutorials for writing Descriptive Paragraphs in the regular course. A ready-to-use Geometry Study Unit is provided in the junior course.

Color Coding and Diagramming is Senari Software's unique method of teaching basic grammar. Students learn to assign specific colors to parts of speech before attempting to diagram a sentence. The visual relationship provided by the color-coding helps them to understand how the words relate to one another. This makes diagramming easy and meaningful.

The instructional material for grammar included on the disk has been successfully used by home-schoolers, ESL and Special Education Teachers.
